NOTE CONCERNING LIBRARY ENTITLEMENT:

Pending their election by Council*, applicants, who are required to pay their subscription and entrance fee totalling £35 on applying to join the Society, may use the Library free of charge.

Please note that subscriptions received after 30 September will include the whole of the next calendar year.

* Council meets in November, January, March and May. The Huguenot Society reserves the right not to approve an application for membership.

IMPORTANT NOTES CONCERNING GIFT AID

1. For this Gift Aid to be valid, you must have paid an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the Society reclaims on your membership subscription and donations in the tax year.

This is currently 28p for every pound you pay – equivalent to the standard rate of 22% of the gross amount. The recovery rate reduces to 25p per pound in 2008/2009, although with transitional relief, the former rate will continue until 2010/2011.

2. Your signature does not need to be witnessed and you may cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Membership Secretary in writing. It will not then apply to any subsequent subscription or donation.
3. If you no longer pay an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax equal to the tax that the Society reclaims, you should advise the Membership Secretary in writing.
4. If you change your name or address, you should also inform the Membership Secretary.
