

HOW TO PROCEED IF YOU ARE RESEARCHING AN ANCESTOR YOU BELIEVE MAY BE HUGUENOT

If you wish to do your own research at the Huguenot Library, which holds the 61 volumes of the *Quarto Series*, the Society's *Proceedings*, the Wagner pedigrees and Family Research files, as well as a vast collection of printed books and many unique manuscript and archive resources, please contact the Society's Librarian to make an appointment, at library@huguenotsociety.org.uk or by telephone on 020 7679 2046. The Librarian can search surname indexes for the above mentioned publications and unpublished research files prior to finalising the appointment if you need confirmation that there are occurrences of the name in our records. Due to time limitations, surname searches are limited to people wishing to consult Huguenot Society material at the Library. **However any occurrences of a surname may not concern your particular ancestor(s)** and it would be up to you to research a possible link. You are advised to work back to the early 1800s using civil and parish registration, as the majority of Huguenot Registers do not extend beyond this period.
