IMPORTANT NOTES CONCERNING GIFT AID

1. For this Gift Aid to be valid, you must have paid an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the Society reclaims on your membership subscriptions and donations in the tax year. The rate is currently 25p for every pound.
2. Your signature does not need to be witnessed and you may cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Membership Secretary in writing. It will not then apply to any subsequent subscription or donation.
3. If you no longer pay an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax equal to the tax that the Society reclaims, you should advise the Membership Secretary in writing.
4. If you change your name or address, you should also inform the Membership Secretary.
